



PET POLICY

Staying at The Glynhill with a pet is an additional £15 per room per night. This covers the cost of extra measures after check-out for cleaning. If pets are paying direct, not their hoomans, we only accept cash and credit/debit cards, no bones.

Pets are allowed in bedrooms and the reception lounge with their hooman companions, so long as they always keep their companions attached to them by leash.

We allow a maximum of two pets per room when travelling with their family. Children are also allowed on request.

We all carry a little extra weight from time to time, however pets should be 50lbs or under. If your friend is a little larger, or carrying some seasonal weight, do speak to us. We will make exceptions for good behaviour.

Without prejudice, pets are not allowed in our main bar and restaurant area or else our waiting staff will get no work done whilst they make googly eyes at your dogs, cats and assorted furry friends. We do have a great outside terrace to be enjoyed by all, Scottish weather permitting. Working dogs are the exception to this when they are on duty.

All pets should be advised that their hoomans will be responsible for any damage to hotel property, so we greatly appreciate their good-boy and good-girl behaviour whilst staying.

We kindly ask hooman companions to contact reception to arrange housekeeping to service their room whilst staying. We may ask that pets wait in the lounge whilst the room is being serviced. We are of course happy to provide drinking water for pets and hoomans whilst they wait.

Barks, Meows, and hooman singing should be kept to a minimum whilst staying in respect our other guests. We would also appreciate if reception could be notified if any pet needs to be left in the room alone for any time.
